



Additional Recycling Information

There is no charge for recyclables.

Additional items that you can bring to the recycling center at Appalachian Court at no cost:

Batteries
Engine oil
Engine coolant
Scrap metal

Charges for Bagged Trash
\$1.00 for each bag of trash up to 33 gallons.
\$3.00 for bags larger than 33 Gallons

Open Tuesday to Saturday, 8:00-5:00
(except holidays)

Paint:

cans with wet paint - \$5.00 per gallon can
cans with dried paint (you bring it with kitty litter already mixed in) - \$0.50 per gallon can

Small tires*: \$4.00 (4 free per Pickens resident in April for the Great American Cleanup)

Large tires*: \$7.00

Sofa or loveseat: \$10.00

Crib mattress: \$5.00

Mattress up to king: \$15.00

Recliner: \$5.00

Any size boxspring: \$15.00

Air conditioner: \$12.00

Refrigerator or freezer: \$12.00

*all tires must be off the rim

Items that cannot be recycled:

Plastic bags or recyclables inside plastic bags - you can take these to Kroger and Ingles

Takeaway coffee cups

Disposable nappies

Garden waste

Polystyrene (foam)

Bubble wrap

Syringes or medical waste

Dead animals

Ceramics, ovenware, or light bulbs

Used paper plates

Plastic forks, spoons, and plastic knives

Used napkins

Plastic oil cans

Pizza boxes
